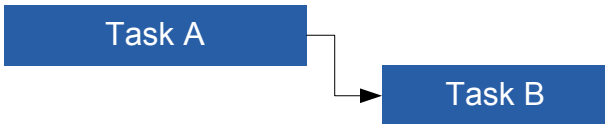


Project Relationship Types

A relationship between two tasks means that the start or finish of a task is dependant on the start or finish of another task.

In these examples Task B is dependant upon Task A.

Finish to Start (default)

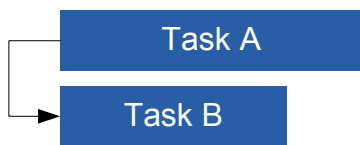


Task A must finish for Task B to start

Example

The shopping must be done before dinner can be cooked

Start to Start

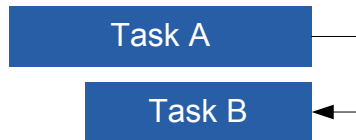


Task A must start for Task B to start

Example

The security guard must have started for the work to commence

Finish to Start (default)

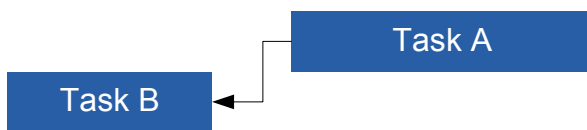


Task A must finish for Task B to finish

Examples

The call-centre cannot finish till the road-works finish.

Finish to Start (default)



Task A must start for Task B to finish

Examples

Post sales support must start for pre-sales support to finish
